NURSERY NEWSLETTER- AUTUMN TERM



The coming term...

Personal, social and emotional development-We will be settling into the new routines and getting to know everyone. We will be explaining the behavioural expectations and supporting children to play collaboratively in all areas.

Communication and language- We will model the use of effective language to the children and encourage them to communicate their ideas with one another. We will start to do some small carpet sessions to help them to develop their listening skills.

Physical development- We will encourage the children to use all of the areas both inside and outside the classroom to develop their fine and gross motor skills. We will introduce 'Dough Disco' and 'Squiggle while you wiggle' to our carpet sessions.

Areas of continuous provision...

The classroom has been split up into areas of continuous provision that are designed to give the children the opportunity to access all of the EYFS curriculum. We have sand and water, a book corner, jigsaws, a maths area, a writing area, a making area, construction and a home corner to name but a few. All of the areas have basic resources that stay all year and we enhance them to bring learning on and explore the children's interests. This play based curriculum allows us to meet all of the targets put in place to enable the children to move up to reception and hit the early learning goals.
