How will Year 1 be different in the Spring term?

During the Spring term, we will be working with a blended learning approach. We will be working together as a whole class in the morning for English and maths, with no access to areas of provision. In the afternoon, children will have access to our areas of provision whilst we work in small groups.

English

We will be starting our next Talk for Writing unit on the story Little Red Riding Hood. As part of this work, we will be learning about nouns and adjectives, and we'll then use this to change some of the nouns and adjectives to create a new version of the story. Once we have planned a new version, we will then write it. When writing, we will be applying everything we learned in the Autumn term, including using a capital letter, full stop and finger spaces. We'll finish learning the remaining cursive lower-case letters.

Phonics

We have now learned all of the Chapter 4a sounds. We will spend this whole term recapping all of the Chapter 3 and 4a sounds and use these to read and spell words, including longer words with 2 or more syllables. We will continue to practice reading and spelling the TRICKY WORDS from Chapters 2 – 4a before moving onto new sounds and tricky words in Chapter 4b.

Maths

This term, we will be working with numbers to 50. We will be counting, ordering and comparing numbers as well as learning about the value of each digit in a 2-digit number. We will also be using methods that we have already learned to add and subtract within 50 using concreate apparatus as well as drawn/written methods. We will then move onto measuring the length, height, weight and volume of a variety of objects.


