English

This half term our focus will be on writing a traditional tale and a recipe. We are looking at the book 'The Gingerbread Man' and will be writing our own version of it before creating a recipe for how to bake our own Gingerbread Men which we will then follow!

Maths

Our focus will be numbers to 50, length, height, mass and capacity. Please practice counting with your children all the way up to 50 and backwards at home.

RE

We will be finding out all about sacred times in different religions. We will be investigating Easter, Eid-al-fitr and Passover and learning how and why these are celebrated.

Science

Our focus will be on plants. We will be learning about their structure; their life cycle and we will be able to name a variety of common plants. We will also be completing our own investigation to see which conditions plants grow best in!

Homework

Online learning tasks will be set weekly via *Purple Mash* – these will be maths focused. Children can access a variety of different tasks on *Purple Mash* as well.

Reading Books

Reading books are sent home each night. It is essential that you are reading with your child as much as possible and recording it in their reading record. Books are changed on a Friday.

History

Our focus this half term is History and we will be looking at the difference between Middleton and an African village. We will be using the text 'Handa's Surprise' to help us throughout this unit of work.
