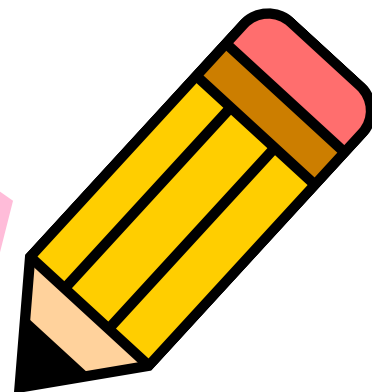


# Welcome to Year 6
