- To use geographical language, maps and atlases to describe and understand the location and key geographical features of North, Central and Southern America.

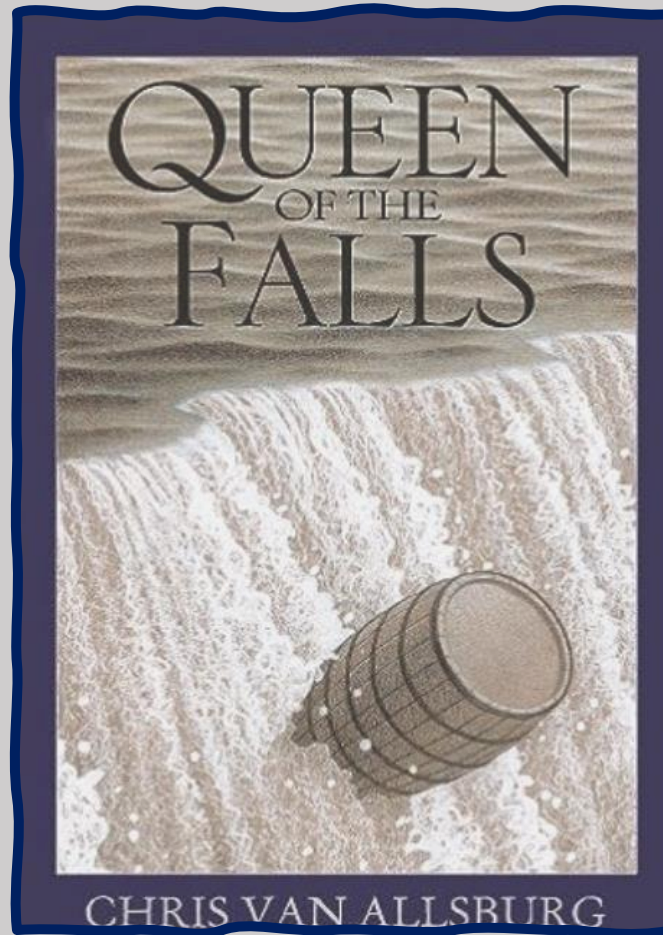
As **artists**, we will:
