Early Education Entitlement

Our nursery is open 38 weeks of the year, in accordance with the school's published term times. The Nursery is not open during school holidays/bank holidays.

We offer childcare and education for children aged 3 – 11 years, from 7:30am to 6:00pm, and for 2 year olds from 8.30am to 3:15pm.

We are able to provide eligible families with:

- 30 hours childcare for working families of children aged 2 years upwards
- 15 hours funding for all 3 and 4-year-olds
- 15 hours funding for 2-year-olds receiving some additional forms of support (disadvantaged).
- Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP)
- Disability Access Funding (DAF)

Times

The following sessions are available within our nursery:

- Morning session: 8.30am to 12 noon (3.5 hour session)
- Morning session plus lunchtime: 8.30am to 1pm. (4.5 hour session)
- All day session: 8.30am 3.15pm (6.75 hour session)

A packed lunch or a hot lunch option is available at £2.95 per day.

Childcare Vouchers

We currently accept childcare vouchers from a variety of different providers. You will be able to pay for Nursery Fees and Supplementary contribution with Childcare Vouchers. They cannot be used to pay for school trips, dinners or snacks.
