- Locate key places in northern Europe, explaining the impact of climate on the movement of people of the past.

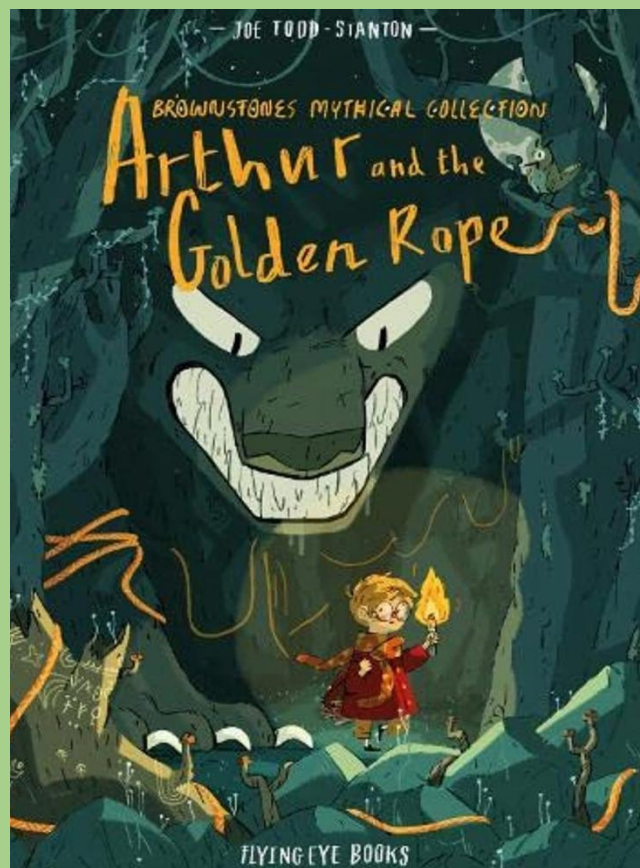
As **artists**, we will:
