As **writers**, inspired by 'Journey' and the language of Berlie Doherty, we will:

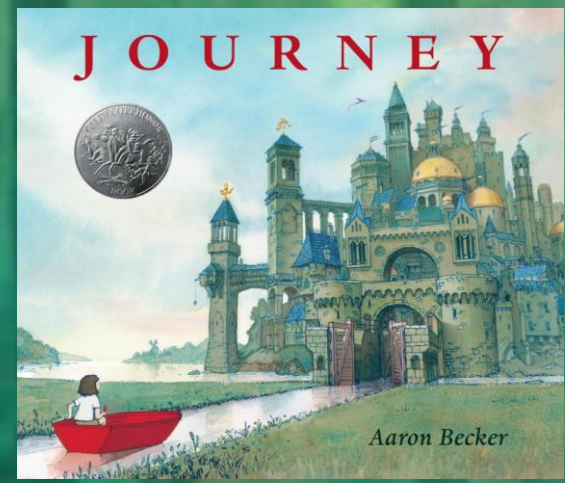
- write an adventure story.
