- Draw inferences and justify them with evidence from the text.

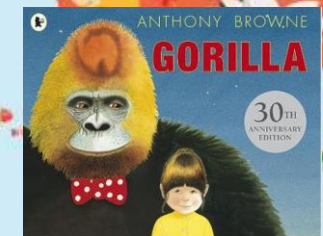
Year 4 – Autumn A
