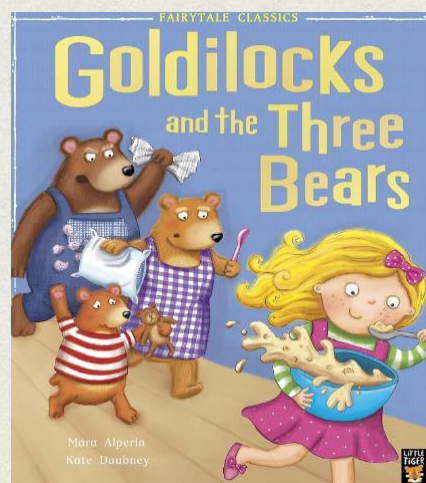
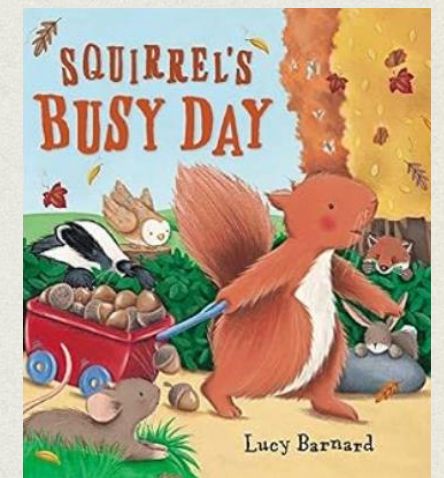
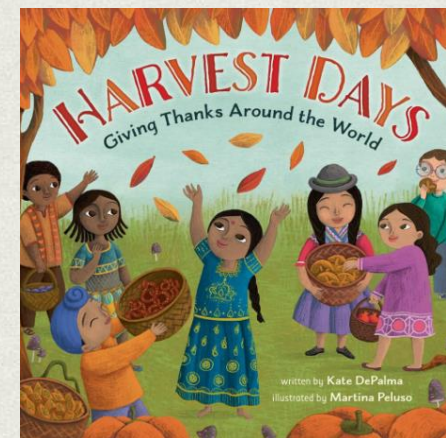
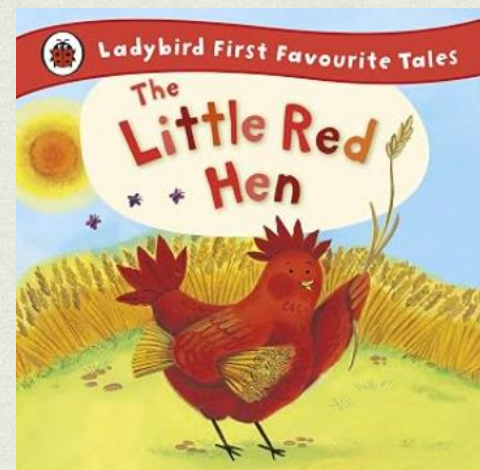
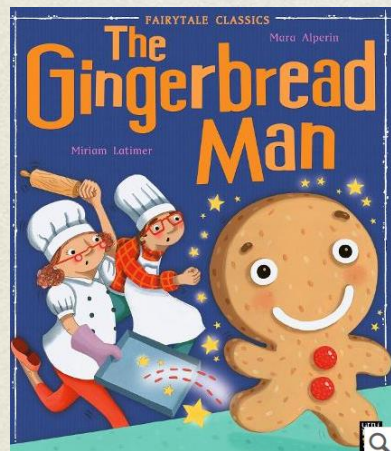
AUTUMN TERM



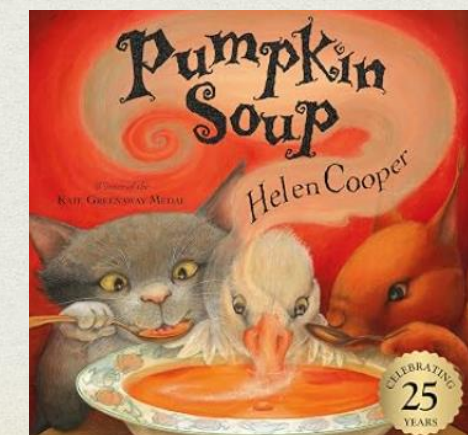
This half term our topic will begin by looking at some Traditional Tales.

NURSERY



The environment and the activities in Nursery are carefully planned in order to provide a rich range of learning experiences for all children. In Nursery we follow a topic-based approach, as well as responding to certain events that may occur throughout the year such as Harvest or Bonfire Night. There are 7 Areas of Learning in the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS), which our activities are planned around:

Communication and Language

Literacy

Mathematics

Understanding the World

Expressive Arts and Design

A TYPICAL DAY IN NURSERY



- 8:30am-8:45am: Children arrive in to Nursery and go into free play.
- 8:50am-9am: Register, Good Morning song, Days of the week song, Weather Song, Let Your Light Shine Song and Feelings Check In
- 9am-9:30am: Free play inside or outside
- 9:35am-9:50am: Small group activities.
- 9:50-10am: Dough Disco and Story
- 10am- 10:20am: Snack Time
- 10:20-11:15am: Free Play, inside or outside
- 11:15am-11:30am: Small group activities
- 11:30am-11:45am: Story/Singing, then get ready for lunch
- 11:45-1pm- Lunch in the hall then back to Nursery room for free play (outside)
- 1pm-1:15pm: Afternoon register and story/singing
- 1:15pm- 1:45pm: Free play
- 1:45-2pm: Small group activities
- 2pm-2:45pm: Free play
- 2:45pm-3:15pm: Tidy, story/singing and get ready for home time.

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KEY WORKERS



All our children are assigned a Key Worker for their time in Nursery. You will have received a message informing you who your child's Key Worker will be. They will work closely with your child to build a secure relationship and support them as they learn, develop and grow during their time with us.



FOREST SCHOOL



- We take part in Forest School which is on a Wednesday afternoon with Miss Stokes.
- Please bring in wellies and waterproofs for this day. These can be left in Nursery if you wish.
- It would be very helpful if all items of clothing and shoes are labelled with your child's name.



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PHONICS



During the children's time in Nursery, we have a strong focus on developing their speaking and listening skills. We will help the children to hear the sounds around them, such as environmental and instrumental sounds, as well as supporting them to develop rhythm, rhyme and alliteration.

We then begin teaching Phonics in the Summer term for those children who are in their final term before beginning Reception. (Pre-School). This is done following the Read Write Inc scheme.



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MATHS



Maths in Nursery is taught following the First 4 Maths scheme, which is also used by the rest of the school. During the week, the children will complete age appropriate and engaging play-based Maths activities to support them with their learning.

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TAPESTRY



We use Tapestry to provide you with an insight to all the fun things we get up to in Nursery. We will upload pictures, videos and comments to your child's Tapestry to show you all the super learning that is happening.

If you are having any troubles with accessing Tapestry please get in touch with one of the Nursery team and we can sort this for you.



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SAFER EATING



Your child's safety, health, and happiness are our highest priorities. Part of this is ensuring that we are promoting safe eating during snack and meal times.

We carefully follow guidance that details how to safely prepare food for all children. If you will be providing your child with a packed lunch from home, we would be very grateful if this guidance could be kept in mind whilst doing so. There is a copy of this guidance on our class page on the school website as well as a physical copy for you to take home at the end of this presentation.
