### **Proposed Fundraising**

Cake sales – this is an easy event to run with no expenses.

Discos - Proposed date of Friday 14<sup>th</sup> November. KS1 to be held straight from school for 45mins 3.30 pm – 4.15 pm. KS2 to be held at 4.30 pm – 5.30 pm. Suggestion for KS1 to bring a change of clothes and to go straight into the disco.

Christmas Movie night – market it as present wrapping night for parents.

Family fest – suggest to do one event instead of 2 separate event. To be held on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> July 2026. Feedback from last year was that parents found the two ticket system confusing. Agreed that the 2026 event will be a one ticket event.

Christmas fair – Friday 5<sup>th</sup> December, 3.15pm – 5.30pm. Suggest to hold a team cake sale along with refreshments. A separate meeting will need to be held to plan this event.

Refreshments at nativity – If we sell hot drinks they will need to be sold in an insulated cup with lid. Sell some cakes.

Refreshments at KS2 Christmas carol concert in Church 16<sup>th</sup> December 6pm – mulled wine in lidded cups. Refreshments from 5.30 pm. Children to be at Church by 6pm.

Sports day refreshments on 21<sup>St</sup> May (reserve date 4<sup>th</sup> June).

Bunbury's got talent - potential to hold this in Spring. Ticketed event where children plan and enter themselves.

### Improvements for the year ahead:

Forward plan committee meetings.

Google docs for job lists for events – NB to help us use google docs.

Jobs to be delegated to willing volunteers.

Plan volunteers so that there are minimum number of volunteers and a maximum.

150 club – this needs to checked, Miss B Stubbs to confirm how many people and who paid in to the 150 club account. We need to roll over anyone who paid into it last year. Mrs Badger to check when the last draw was.

# Any other business

More cost effective to order double the amount of reception teddies – purchase the teddies in advance for the following year.

HW is proposing to step down from chairperson role after this school year. Suggest to put the feelers out for a chairperson for the next school year or vice chair to start in spring.

Communication via the new communication WatsApp group worked well. We need someone for reception. Someone to investigate if there is a Nursery WhatsApp group.

Someone to create a poster to promote the funds we raised last year.

We had lots of willing volunteers at most events which would be good to continue.
