Why Oceans Matter	Ocean Map: Label the five world oceans and locate the Great Barrier Reef on a world map.	Oxygen Poster: Create an infographic explaining how oceans produce over half the world's oxygen.	"What If?" Essay: Write a story or report on what would happen to Earth if the oceans disappeared.
Marine Life	Species Fact file: Choose a marine animal and research its habitat, diet, and threats.	Food Chain Model: Create a 3D model of a marine food chain, highlighting the impact of overfishing.	Adaptation Report: Research a deep-sea creature and explain how it has adapted to survive.
Human Impact	Waste Diary: Keep a log of all plastic waste your household creates in one week.	Letter to Authority: Write a letter to a local council or shop explaining why single-use plastics should be banned.	TED Talk: Record a 2-minute "TED Talk" about the dangers of marine litter and solutions.
