This objective can be practiced in a variety of ways. Here are some ideas:

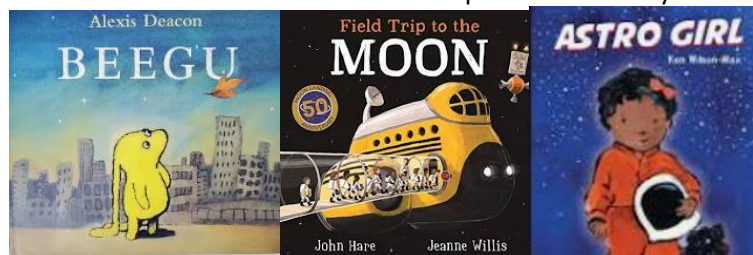
- Finding number pairs (cards) to make 20
