Spelling

While your children will learn and be taught in school how to spell phonetically plausible words based on their phonics level and books. By the end of Year 1 children are also expected to know and spell a list of statutory spellings, most of these words do not follow our spelling rules or phonic patterns, making them trickier to remember. Please practice these words with your child at home as we will continue to support their spelling of them in school. My suggestion would be to tackle three words each week and then continuing to revise previously learnt words as you go along.

Counting to 10 from any given number, forwards and backwards to zero
Addition and subtraction within 10, including missing numbers for example:
