



Spotlight on Year 6

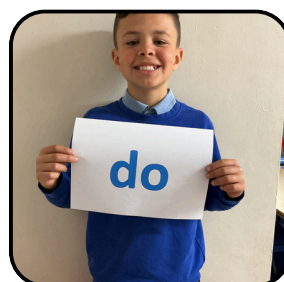
