HOMEWORK

- ▶ **Reading** - please read with your child three times a week and record in reading records. Your child's reading band and day are noted in their reading record.
- ▶ **Guided Reading** - your child's school guided reading is based on a novel, they may bring this home to pre-read, however, it is essential these books are brought in every day.
- ▶ **Spellings** - any tests will be on a Monday or Tuesday.
- ▶ **Times tables** - any tests are every Friday. By the end of Year 3 children are expected to have good recall of x2 x5 x10 x3 x4 x8. Any tests will take place on a Monday or Tuesday.
