

- ► Times Tables By the end of Year 2 children are expected to have good recall of x2 x5 x10 x3. Any tests will take place on a Monday or Tuesday.

### Assessment and National Curriculum Tests (SATS)

- Optional carried out, usually in May, to assist with teacher assessment -Reading Paper 1 and 2; Maths Paper 1 (Arithmetic) and Maths Paper 2 (Reasoning and Problem Solving)
- Optional teacher assessment frameworks are also used to assist with teacher assessment in writing and reading
