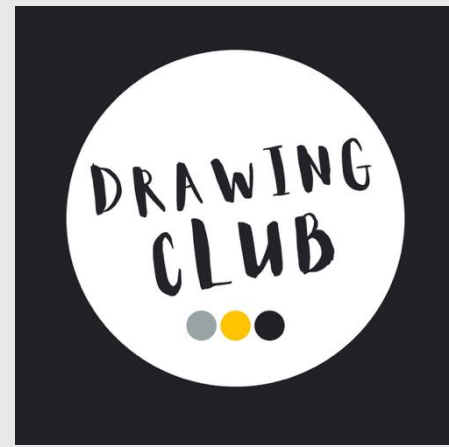
- PE kits must be in every Monday and will be returned on a Friday.

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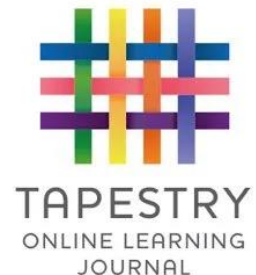

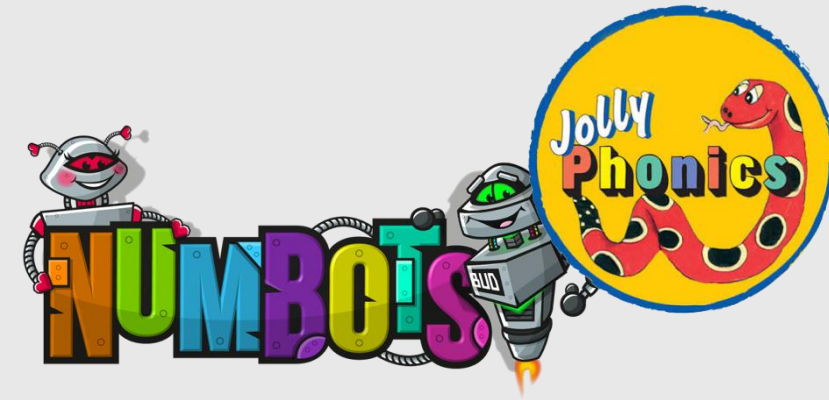


Tapestry

- Maths – Will be set on Numbots. It is expected that each child will complete at least 10 minutes a week on the program. Maybe Spring term

- Reading – the children will be read with in school on a weekly basis. Each child will be read with by myself or Mrs Ferguson. Your child's day will be in their reading diaries. We would like you to read a minimum of 3 times a week with your child. Please sign your child's reading record to indicate that they have finished reading the book so that we can change it.

Outdoor learning
