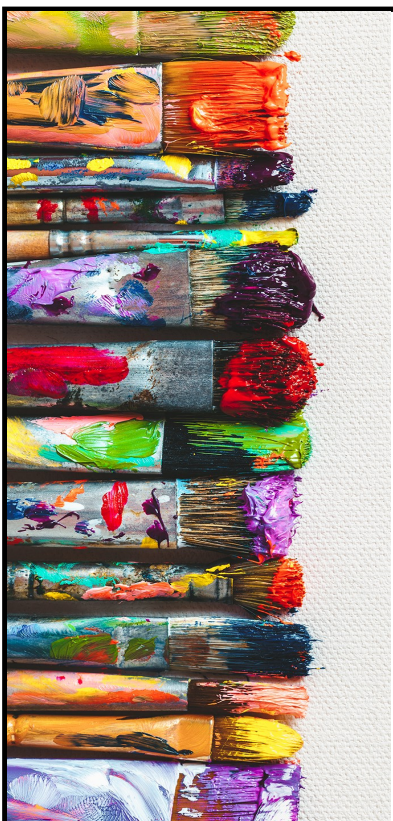
Art and Design is ...

Art and Design is about expanding creativity and imagination. Art can be drawing, painting, print making, sculpting and textile making. In art lessons, you will explore the visual, tactile and sensory qualities of materials and processes and begin to understand and use colour, shape and space, pattern and texture, to represent your own ideas and feelings.



Someone who studies art is called an artist.

There are many types of artists including painters, sculptors and textile artists. In KS1 we will be learning about Pablo Picasso, Joan Miró, Helen Wilde, George Seurat, Earnst Haeckel and Giorgio Morandi.



I will be learning these skills in art:

- Use a range of materials creatively to design and make products.
- Use drawing, painting and sculpture to develop and share my ideas, experiences and imagination .
- Develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space .
- Describe the differences and similarities between different practices and disciplines, and make links to my own work.
