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Language topics:

Fact Files: The children will be creating a detailed fact file on an animal of their choice.

Instruction Writing: The children will learn about the features of instruction writing and write a set of their own detailed instructions.

Diary Writing: We will be writing a diary entry for a polar explorer. The children will learn about the features of a diary and look at different examples of diary entries.

Topic: Brrr...It's Cold!!: Investigating food chains, animal adaptations, temperature, using maps and learning about famous explorers.
