MacMillan Coffee and Cake - Friday 26th September.

You are all welcome to join us on Friday 26th September as we hold our annual MacMillan Coffee and Cake Fundraiser.

We would be very grateful for any donations of cakes that we can sell during the day (homemade or shop bought). If you can help support this event by donating some cakes, please drop them off at school from Thursday September 25th (shop bought) and Friday morning September 26th for homemade.

Please also help us by environmentally friendly by bringing along your own reusable coffee mugs if you have them. We will have some cups for those who do not have one!

The coffee sessions will take place in the school hall and your child can be released from class to join you if you wish.

Nursery to Year 2 – Arrive between 9am and 10am

If you have a child in both key stages, then you may attend at the most convenient time for you.

If your child has a food allergy, please could you send them with their own cake as we cannot take responsibility for cakes that are made outside of school.

We are looking forward to welcoming you into the school and for helping us raise some much-needed funds for a fantastic cause.

Medical Issues

Some children are being sent to school with medication such as Calpol in their school bags. Oral medicines etc. are not allowed on school premises and cannot be administered by staff except in exceptional circumstances when children need vital medication prescribed by a doctor during School hours on an on-going basis.

Parents should contact the Headteacher so that special arrangements can be made.

Parent may come into school to administer medication providing you let the appropriate staff know in advance.

If your child has a specific medical condition requiring medication, please contact the Headteacher. You will appreciate that medicines in School can constitute a danger to other children.

Please be aware and follow national guidelines if your child has Diarrhoea and/or vomiting by keeping your child away from school for 48 hours from last episode of diarrhoea or vomiting. This greatly helps stop the spread of this illness to other pupils and staff.

Swimming lessons At Derwen

Years 3 to 6

We are currently reviewing swimming lessons for KS2 pupils as costs are continuing to rise. To give parents an idea, a 6-week course would cost approximately £45 per child, and a 4-week course around £30 per child. These figures are based on all pupils attending.

In the past, the school has subsidised the cost of swimming lessons for all pupils to help bring the price down for families. Unfortunately, due to the increasing financial pressures on school budgets, we are no longer in a position to do this.

Another challenge we face is that when some families choose not to send their children to lessons, the overall cost for those who do attend becomes higher, and the school has to cover the shortfall.
