

# Addition and Subtraction Year 2

Add	To bring two or more numbers (or things) together to make a new total.		
Total	The result of adding.		
Subtract	To take one number away from another.		
Greater Than	Bigger.  The symbol > means greater than		
Less than	Smaller.  The symbol < means less than		
Fact Families	A fact family is a group of math facts using the same numbers. For addition/subtraction, you use three numbers and get four facts.  Eg: 10, 2, and 12: $10 + 2 = 12$ , $2 + 10 = 12$ $12 - 10 = 2$ $12 - 2 = 10$

# Greater/Less than or Equal to

We use the symbols >, < and = to compare the values of number sentences.

(10) 
$$6+4$$
 <  $6+5$  (11)

$$(10)$$
 6 + 4  $(>)$  3 + 6

(7) 
$$11-4 = 12-5$$
 (7)

< means Less than (7) 
$$11 - 4$$
 (8)

> means Greater than




Therefore 5 + 3 = 4 + 4
