Name	Florence Beatrice Price	10 a
Born	9th April 1887	
Died	3 June 1953	
Information	Florence Beatrice Price was an American classical composer, pianist, organist and music teacher. Price is noted as the first African-American woman to be recognised as a symphonic composer, and the first to have a composition played by a major orchestra.	
Influences	She was a deeply religious person, so brought the music of the African American church into her music, as well as influences from the likes of Dvořák, Tchaikovsky and other European Romantic composers.	

Vocabulary		
Orchestra	A large group of musicians who play together on a variety of string, wind and percussion instruments.	
Composer	Someone who writes music.	
Ensamble	A group of people who perform instrumental or vocal music	
Tempo	The speed of the music	
Unison	Playing exactly the same note or note within the octave	
Harmony	The sound of two or more notes at the same time	
Structure	How a song is put together	
Chorus	Repeating section of a song, comes in-between verses to seperate
