

| Photography | The <u>skill, job</u> , or process of producing photographs. | |

| Editing | The process of changing, correcting or adapting something | |

| Rotate/Flip | Turn an image by 90 degrees or flip it to make a 180 degree mirror image | |

| Luminosity | How light something is - a measure of how close an image or colour is to pure white something is or pure black. | |
| Contrast | The degree of difference between the <u>darker</u> and <u>lighter</u> parts of a <u>photograph</u> . | |
| Enlarge | To make an image or part bigger. | |
| Reduce | To make an image or part smaller. | |

Handy Tools

The adjustments tab allows us to change the colour, contrast and luminosity of the image.



Recolour allows us to replace one colour with another.



The Clone Stamp copies pixels from one area of the picture to another.



The Magic Wand tool allows us to select areas of pixels with a similar colour.
