| Reproduction | The process by which living things create young or offspring |

| Sperm | A cell made by males. These fertilise the female so that they can reproduce |
| Physical | relating to the body |
| Pubic Hair | Hair that grows over the external male and female private parts |
| Emotional | Having to do with strong feeling or emotion. |
| Feelings | An emotion; Love, anger, joy, and fear |
