## Key Vocabulary Puberty The stage or age at which a person experiences the development of the reproductive system The sequence of changes that a living thing Lifecycle goes through as it grows and develops Reproduction The process by which living things create young or offspring **Breasts** The front part of the body between the neck and the stomach: chest Sperm A cell made by males. These fertilise the female so that they can reproduce Physical relating to the body Pubic Hair Hair that grows over the external male and female private parts Emotional Having to do with strong feeling or emotion. Feelings An emotion; Love, anger, joy, and fear
