#### Key Words to learn and use:

Aqueduct- a passage used for carrying water from a distance

**Amphitheatre-** a place where Romans went to watch animals and people fighting.

**Archaeologists**– people who study remains from ancient times.

**Barbarian-** a person who lived outside the Roman Empire, seen as having a violent nature.

**Boudicca -** Queen of the Iceni tribe who fought against Romans

Celts- pre Roman inhabitants of Britain.

Centurion- a Roman soldier in charge of 80 foot soldiers.

**Chariot**- a two wheeled card pulled by horses used for racing a riding into battle.

**Claudius –** Roman Emperor 41-54AD who extended Roman Empire into Britain.

Emperor- the leader of an empire

Fort -a fortified building in a strategic position.

**Groma –** a wooden cross with weights used to make the roads straight.

**Hadrian**—Roman Emperor 117-138AD secured borders and ordered the build of a wall

**Invasion–** to enter as an enemy, by force, to take control. **Latin-** he language spoken and written by the Romans.

**Mosaic**- a pattern made from coloured pieces of stones and pottery.

#### Roman facts and figures:


Around 50 countries today were in the
