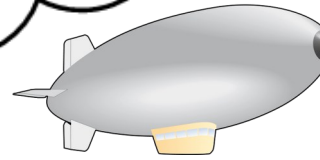


The first manned flight was in a **hot air balloon** in 1783.



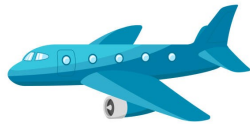
Airships (also called zeppelins) were created about 80 years later.



The next type of flying machine built was a **glider**, in 1891.



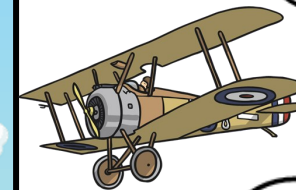
1960s: **rockets** fly to space and back for the first time.

HISTORY OF FLIGHT

People have been flying abroad on **passenger jets** since the 1940s.



The **Wright brothers** built and flew the first working **biplane** in 1903.

Amelia Earhart flew solo across the Atlantic Ocean in 1932.



Jet engines and jet planes were invented in the 1930s, a **decade** after the first around-the-world flight.
