

Wonderful Words to Learn and Use

aerial view	A view from above.
facilities	Buildings, equipment or services designed to make life easier or better for a community.
human geography	Features of the land that have been built or made by humans.
landscape	A big part of the Earth's surface that you can see from one place.
map	A drawing that represents a particular area such as a city, a country or a continent.
navigate	To find your way or help someone else find their way around.
physical geography	Natural features of the landscape, that would be there even without humans.
street furniture	Objects placed or fixed in the street for public use, such as benches, post boxes, road signs and traffic lights.
town	A large group of houses, shops and other buildings where people live and work.
village	A smaller group of houses, which may have a few shops or other buildings like a church.

Top 5 Carnforth Facts

Carnforth is a small market town near Lancaster and Kendal.

It is at the north-west end of Lancashire.

Carnforth has a fire station, a train station, a library, doctors, shops, supermarkets, pubs, churches and schools.

Morecambe Bay is 5 miles away, and two waterways run through Carnforth (the River Keer and the Lancaster Canal).

Almost eight thousand people live in Carnforth, including Millhead and Warton.
