Let's go to Greece!



We start of the summer term with a Geography theme: **What is it like to live in Greece?** The children will set up a travel agency in the classroom to promote the islands and find out about the weather, why people go there on holiday, along with their customs and traditions.

In Maths, we start of the term consolidating our number calculations along with looking at fractions and decimals. Times tables will still be a focus. We will also look at money, mass, capacity, and statistics.

In English, our focus is looking at short stories from around the world, working towards writing our own short story based on Greece. Later in the term we will read some Greek Myths then we will look at writing our own.

This term, our Art focus is collage and looking at the Artist Patrick Caulfield. In PHSE we will be looking at relationships focusing on touch. This looks at appropriate and inappropriate touch and enables the children wot explore who they can talk to if they feel uncomfortable in a relationship. In RE, we are looking at Judaism. With our key question being “Who inspires you and who should we follow?” Our topic for Spanish is ‘Where do I live in Spain.’ Looking at Spanish cities and the different places to live in Spain.

In our PE lessons, we will be developing our striking and fielding skills relating to the Sport of cricket. We will be outside on a Thursday, so it is important children have suitable outdoor footwear and a spare pair of socks in their bags. On Monday afternoons we will continue going swimming to Carnforth Swimming pool and this term the focus will be on water safety. It is essential that children have their swimming costumes, shorts and t-shirt, a towel, and bag every Monday. All hair needs to be tied up and no jewellery, especially earrings, must be worn.

Every day we will be working hard to improve our reading, handwriting, spelling, and grammar skills. Home learning will continue to be sent home on Thursday, then ready to return every Tuesday. It is essential that every child practices their times tables this term as each week we will have a set focus.
