A study of Greek lives and their influences

What job would you like?



We end the summer term with a History theme: 'A study of Greek lives and their influences.' The children will go back in time to find out about life and jobs during ancient Greece and how they have influenced the world today.

In Maths, we start of the term concentrating on our times tables, ready for the Year 4 Multiplication test. We will consolidate our understanding of shape and learn about angles and position and direction. Ending off with measurement and consolidation of the four number operations.

In English, our main focus is a Greek Myths looking at 'The Orchard Book of Greek Myths' by Geraldine McCaughrean. Then we will look at non-chronological reports linked to our topic. At the end of term our focus will be poetic styles.

This term, our Design technology focus is making pavilion structures using a weaving technique with cladding. In PHSE we will looking at how we grow and change. In RE, we are looking at 'Hindu Dharma,' with our key question being "Why is family so important to Hindu people?" Our topic for Spanish is 'a trip around Latin America,' looking at other Spanish speaking countries which the children will write a travel diary about. In Computing we will look at programming in Kodu.

In our PE lessons, we will be doing athletics a Thursday so it is important children have suitable outdoor footwear and a spare pair of socks in their bags. On Monday afternoons we will continue going swimming to Carnforth Swimming pool with Mrs Gavriluk. The focus being on water safety and so it is essential that children have their swimming costumes, shorts, t-shirts, a towel, a bag and swimming hat every Monday. All hair needs to be tied if it is longer than your neck and no jewellery, especially earrings, must be worn.

Every day we will be working hard to improve our reading, handwriting, spelling and grammar skills. Home learning will continue to be sent home on Thursday, then ready to return every Tuesday. It is essential that every child practices their times tables this term as each week we will have a set focus.
