Remembrance Service

We held our annual Remembrance Service in school on 11th November. Your children, as ever, were respectful in honouring the service of men and women of the armed forces. The two minutes silence was observed impeccably by every child from the age of four years old in Reception right up to our oldest learners in Year six.



After learning about the courage of Noel Chavasse VC from Liverpool last year, this year children heard about a brave airman who travelled from Trinidad in the Commonwealth to join the Royal Air Force. Ulric Cross served as a pathfinder in Bomber Command during World War 2. He was recognised with two medals for his courage, skill and tenacity.

Poppy wreathes from each class were received and placed on to our school 'cenotaph' by Lilly and Leon, whose brother (an ex-pupil of our school) is a serving soldier in the British army. On the day of our remembrance service, Seth brought in a picture of his great grandad, who served with the Royal Air Force, and this took pride of place on our cenotaph next to our wreathes.

If any family has connections to the local branch of the Royal British Legion, please can you make enquiries to ensure that our school is included in the wreath laying at the Hoole monument

We always seem to miss out, which is a shame when we are committed to commemorating Armistice Day with such respect in our school. Please let me know if you can supply contact details for relevant individuals who can help me to rectify this issue for next November.

We have been very kindly gifted a school season ticket for Cheshire Phoenix Basketball matches.


