



Message from Headteacher

Roadworks

I wrote to families earlier this week regarding roadworks which may cause issues on routes around our school over coming weeks.

From 9th – 27th February, construction works to connect the new Cheshire Archive Centre will require closure of the westbound lane towards Hoole Road along Lightfoot Street.

As a result, Lightfoot Street will be one way only heading from Hoole Road to the mini roundabout at the Westminster Road junction. A diversion route will be clearly signposted directing traffic along Hoole Lane to the A41 Ring Road to access Hoole Road.

This diversion is likely to increase traffic around the school site.

Please take account of these roadworks which may result in some congestion around school and allow plenty of time for your journey to school.

Parking

We are being visited at least once a week by parking enforcement officers.

A fine will apply where any car is parked on double yellow lines.

A fine will apply where any car stops (however briefly) on the yellow or white road markings in front of school to let a child jump out. This applies even when traffic is at a standstill due to people using the zebra crossing.

As a school, we cannot do more to manage parking and traffic around our school or to remind families about parking issues. We are being visited more and more often by parking enforcement officers in response to concerns raised by the local community.

If you come to or from school in a taxi, please encourage the driver to park responsibly without blocking pathways or stopping to wait in unsuitable positions.

Please avoid penalties being issued to our school community.



On Saturday, a dedicated team of runners headed to the athletics track at Ellesmere Port to compete in the third cross country race of the series.



The aim of this production is to encourage the children to practise their times tables through singing, dancing and acting, while also giving them the opportunity to perform in front of an audience!




Year 4 Parents and carers are invited to attend the performances, either at 3.25pm or 4.55pm. Please return your slips with your preference of show to the School Office.

OPSS issues Product Recall on Hobbycraft Giant Box of Craft (PSD case number 2601-0364).

The Office for Product Safety and Standards (OPSS) has issued a Product Recall to warn about a safety risk associated with the Hobbycraft Giant Box of Craft.

The recall relates to vials of coloured sand included in the product, which may be contaminated with asbestos, a banned substance that poses a health risk even at very low levels of exposure. The product does not meet the requirements of the General Product Safety Regulations 2005.

Consumers are advised to stop using the product immediately and keep it out of the reach of children. If the sand has been used, clean up sites where the product was used using wet cloths to avoid generating dust. Wear gloves and a mask. Double bag the sand, gloves, mask and cloths. Keep children and other people away from areas where the sand has been used until the area has been cleaned.
