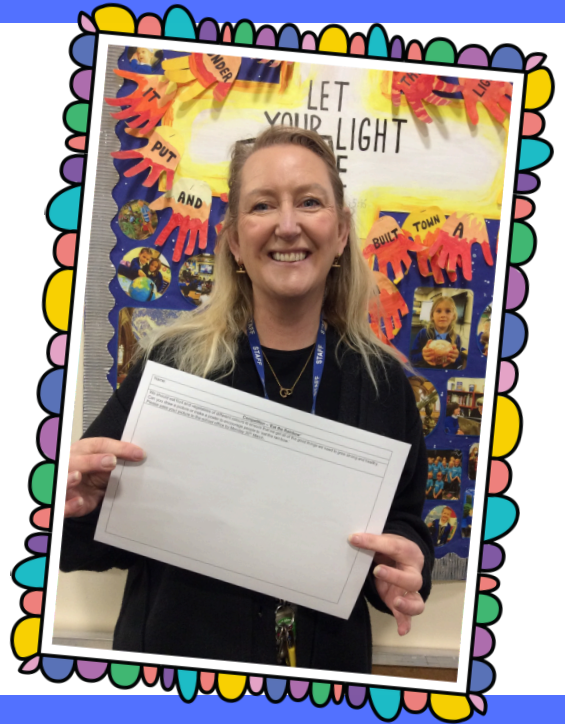
Competition

Pilgrimage

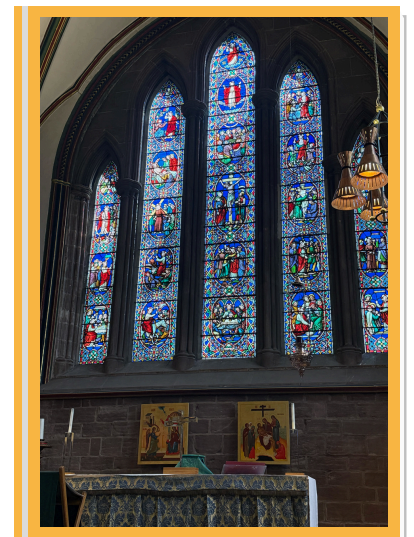


We were very honoured that Hoole Primary was selected to attend a very special event at the Chester Cathedral.

YEAR 5 BIKEABILITY



Our Year 5 pupils have been undertaking their Bikeability awards this week!

Bikeability is a government-funded program that teaches children vital cycling skills for navigating modern roads. It consists of different levels, with Level 1 typically focusing on off-road control in a safe environment, and Level 2 preparing children for cycling on single-lane roads for short journeys like to school or the local shop. The training enhances pupils' physical, social, and academic skills, leading to increased confidence, healthier habits, and a greater ability to judge risks.
