Dear Parents/Carers,

We are very excited to announce we will be holding a Colour Run, which will be held after school on Tuesday 21st July!

If you are not aware of colour runs, they are a fun run (or walk) where participants are doused with different coloured vibrant powders at various points along a course. The colourful powders are made from corn starch. The event is designed to be exciting and inclusive, with an emphasis on a fun memorable experience rather than speed.

If you would like to take part, you must complete the waiver for each participant on the Surveys and Forms tab on School Spider, then make your payment on the Bookings and Payment tab. **For safety reasons, a parent or carer must run with their child. Please ensure that you book a place for ALL participants, whether it be a child or adult.**

The charge for **each participant** (adult or child) is £6.50. (For example, if a mum runs with her son, the cost to participate is £13; if a grandad runs with his 2 grandsons, the cost will be £19.50)

The maximum ratio for children running with an adult is 1 adult to 4 children. The £6.50 charge will include a drink and snack for each participant. Every bit of money raised will be reinvested in our school.

There is also an option to buy small extra pouches of powder (100g) to create your own colour cloud to throw for personal photographs, at the end of the course. Your order can also be made on the Bookings and Payments tab on the School Spider app.

Please complete the permission and payment on the School Spider app before Friday 3rd July. We cannot accept any more participants after the deadline as we have to pre-order the powder and organise the volunteers.

Summary of what to do if you want to participate:

1. Log on the School Spider app (NOT Compass!)
2. Navigate to the Surveys and Permission Tab and click on the Colour Run option
3. Complete the permission survey
4. Navigate to the Bookings and Payment tab
5. Click on the Colour Run Participants option and select the amount of participants – remember, all children must run with an adult so include the adult in your participants amount
6. Pay for your colour run participants
7. (Optional) If you want to pre-order some personal powder pouches, repeat step 5 and 6, but select the Colour Run 100g Powder Pouch option instead of the participants
