
Welcome to Year Two

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<u>Uniform</u>

Our school uniform is:

Your child will be given a new, phonically decodable reading book each Friday. They should be able to read this almost fluently as they will have read the book three times in school during the week. Please return the book on Tuesday of the following week.

Please listen to your child read as often as possible and date and initial the diary each time - you can write a comment if you wish.

Your child will also bring home a 'sharing book', which they will not be able to read on their own. This book is for you to read to and share with your child to develop a love of reading.

Punctuality



Our doors open at 8.45am, ready to start learning at 9.00am, when the classroom doors will be closed. We can all start lessons promptly if everybody arrives on time. Year Two children will leave at 3.15pm. We do ask that you are prompt collecting your child.

School provides a breakfast club each day for $\pounds1$ per day from 8.00am to 8.45am.

Please contact Start Well Learning for information on their after school care.

Please let us know in the morning if somebody different will be collecting your child from school.

Could we please ask that your child brings a book bag to school rather than a back pack – the book bags fit snuggly into the children's trays and there is very little space on the coat pegs for a back pack. The plastic wallet for reading books and diaries also fits into the book bags without having to fold them. Thank you.
