Attendance & Morning Routine

Everyday counts, especially during this final stretch of the year.

- **Start Time:** The school day starts at **8:45 AM**.
- **Lateness:** Children are marked as late if they arrive after **9:00 AM**.
- **School Entry:** All children should access their classrooms directly through their **external classroom doors**.
- **Front Entrance:** Children should **only** enter through the front of the school in exceptional circumstances—such as when arriving late. In these instances, parents/carers must accompany them to the main office to share the reason for the lateness.

School Uniform Expectations

- **When it rains:** Because the weather is so changeable, **please always send your child with a coat or jacket.** We love to get the children outside at break times even if there is a light shower, and they need to be dressed for it!
