



Week 2

Reception have continued to learn about Dougal's Deep Sea Dive and have created some fantastic sea themed paintings!


Year 1 warming up their fingers for writing by threading beads.




Year 1 have been learning about place value and counting to 20. We have extended our learning by using the practical resource numicom.

This week we have expanded the home corner by adding in a washing machine. The children have loved playing with it but also we have used it a lot during maths with Reception counting and finding one more, Year 1 making number bonds with the socks and Year 2's adding amounts on a shopping list.



Week 2 has been another busy week in Class 1. It has been so much fun getting to know the children and they have been fantastic this week with listening and following instructions. We have had so much fun this week, from exploring the washing machine, painting King Charles, using shaving foam to funky brain breaks!

The Key Stage 1 children (Year 1 and 2) have been shining stars and worked their socks off! We have continued to learn about 'Dougal's Deep Sea Diary' using it to write some sentences to describe what Dougal is doing. Year 2 children have expanded their writing further by using subordination (before, when, after). In maths the Year 2 children have been working really hard to tackle some questions based on adding money. Money is really tricky but the children have used the role-play coins to make amounts and work out how much they have.

As a whole class we have learned about Kings and Queens in History, looked at what animals need to survive in Science, thought about what is important to us in RE and sorted objects into computer and not a computer in computing lessons.
