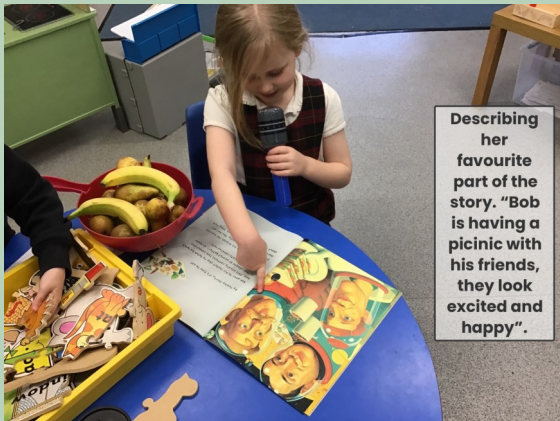
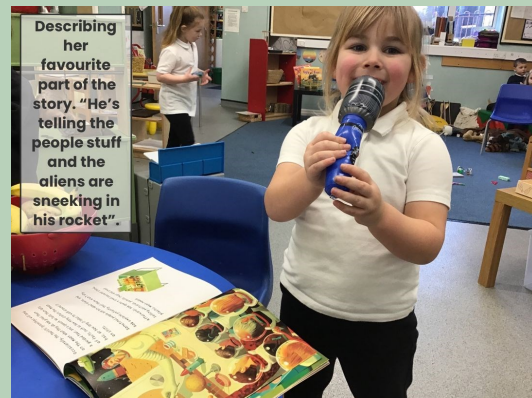


Week 3—WB 19.01.26

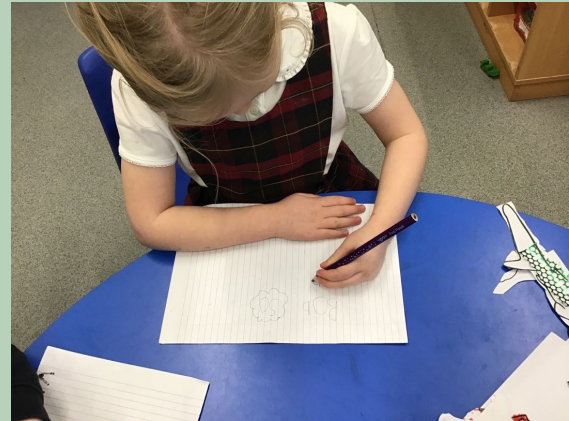

Clapping and stamping to the beat in music.

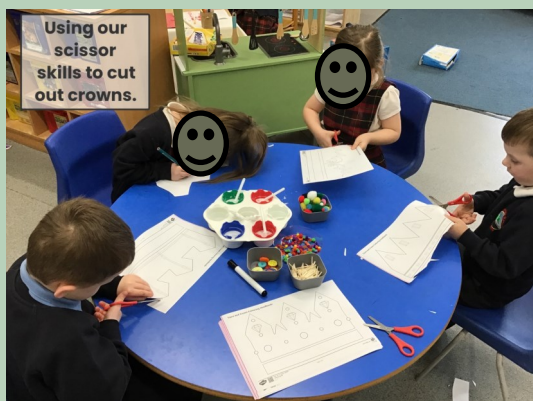


We are getting really good at counting and recognising numbers!
