


Week Beginning 16th March 2026

Another fantastic week in Class 1 as we are rapidly approaching the Easter holidays. The sunshine has enabled us to spend lots of time outside learning!

We completed PE outside this week—working on our jumping skills. We recreated a jungle story, children tip-toed, crawled and completed various jumps over ladders and hurdles.

In English we have continued to learn about Peter Rabbit. We have started to compose sentences about Peter and Mr McGregor. The Year 1 and 2 children have completed an independent short burst write already. The children's writing skills are really coming on now and children are rightly showing pride in the work.

In maths we have been learning about tally marks, data and pictograms. The children have started to gather information which they then write tally marks to represent the amount before creating a pictogram for the data.

The children also went to forest school earlier on in the week where they compared areas of the environment, hunted for bugs, identified plants and flowers and worked well during team building activities.
