

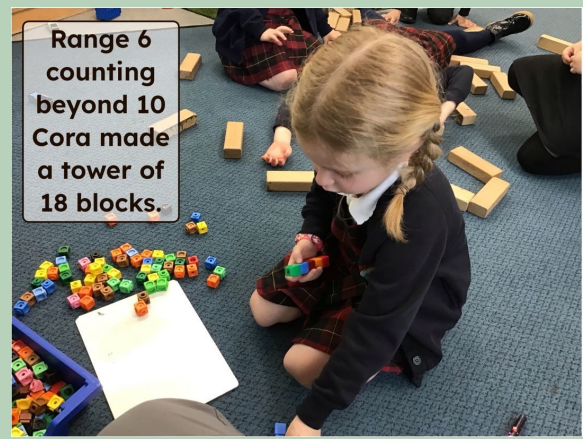
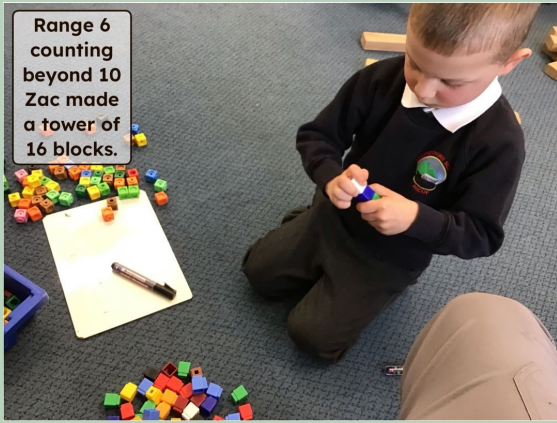
Week Beginning 13th April 2026
