In Class 1 this week it has been very busy . The Year 1 and 2 children have continued their learning on Peter Rabbit and have started writing a modelled write on Peter and Benjamin stealing radishes! In maths we have the very tricky topic of money. It has been hard work but we are now recognising amounts of money and comparing amounts fairly confidently.

In Guided reading this week we have continue with the animal theme with one group reading 'hamster rampage' 3 times this week. The two other groups have read and carried out follow tasks based on the book 'pandas' and 'Luke and the Mule.' These texts directly link to the phonics we have been learning this week from Red Rose phonics.

In Geography we have learned about hot and cold places around the world. In Science we have finished our sorting of animals into categories, such as reptile, mammal etc.

In PSHE we have learned about safe choices and worked well in group discussion.

This week the Key Stage 1 children have been given some homework to complete at home. They have been asked to practise certain timetables to help them build strong foundations in their maths knowledge. Any children who practise their counting and times tables at home will be given lots of Dojo points at school.
