Our first week in class 2!

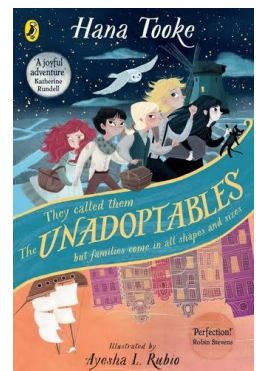
This week has been an exciting start to the year for Class 2! We've spent time settling into our new classroom and new routines and the children have loved sharing what they have been up to over the Summer!
