We continue to ask for a voluntary 50p contribution per week to help provide the children with additional baking or special activities throughout the term

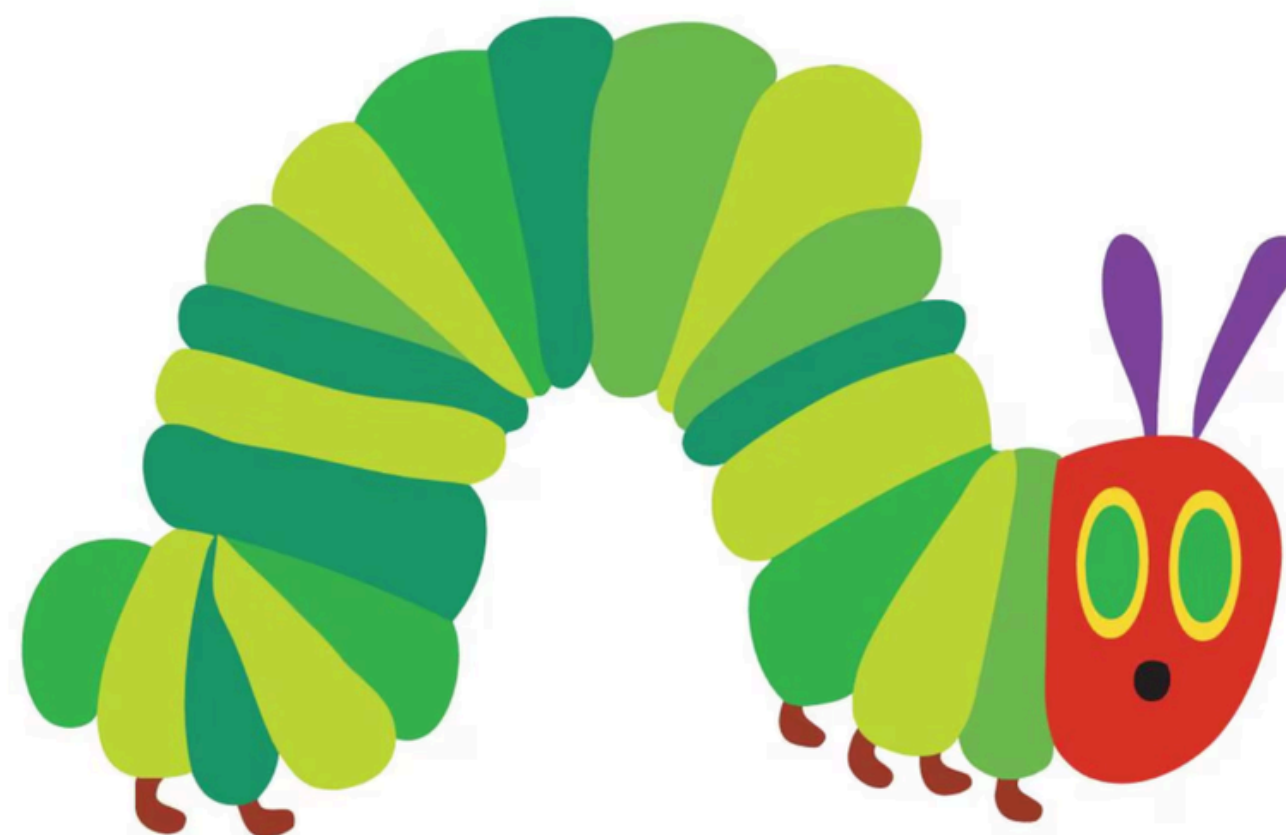


This half term we will be exploring
