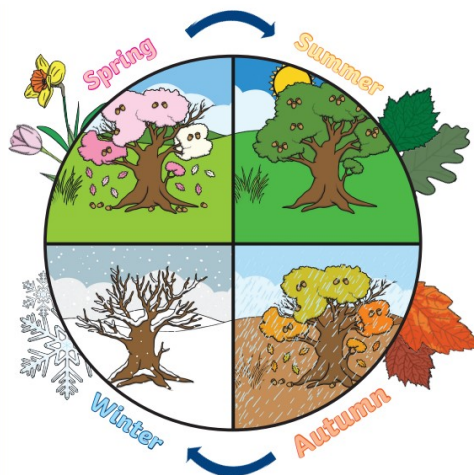


Weather and the Seasons



I can identify the differences between the types of weather experienced in different seasons

Autumn

The temperature begins to fall

Leaves change colour and begin to fall to the ground

As summer turns to Autumn, the days get shorter and the nights get longer.

Winter

As autumn changes to winter, the weather gets even colder.

Sometimes, we might see snow.

The nights are even longer and the days are shorter

Spring

As winter turns to spring, the weather warms up.

Flowers begin to grow like daffodils and blossom will appear on trees

Daylight gets longer during the spring months

Summer

As spring turns to summer, the weather warms up even more

Daytimes are longest during the summer

Sunflowers, lavender and daisies can be seen

Meaning

Autumn

The season before winter and after summer where leaves fall from the trees.

Winter

The coldest season of the year. You might sometimes see snow.

Spring

The season after winter and before summer. The days start to get longer and the weather gets warmer.

Summer

The warmest of all of the seasons

Season

Every year our planet experiences four seasons: autumn, winter, spring and summer.

Fog

A thick cloud made up of little water droplets
