Autumn

Winter

The nights are even longer and the days are shorter

Spring

Flowers begin to grow like daffodils and blossom will appear on trees


Daylight gets longer during the spring months

Summer

Key Words	Meaning
Autumn	The season before winter and after summer where leaves fall from the trees.
Winter	The coldest season of the year. You might sometimes see snow.
Spring	The season after winter and before summer. The days start to get longer and the weather gets warmer.
Summer	The warmest of all of the seasons
Sunrise	When the sun appears to come up in the morning
Sunset	When the sun appears to go down at night time
Hail	Pellets of frozen rain
Sleet	Rain with a little bit of ice that has started to melt
Fog	A thick cloud made up of little water droplets
