We can't believe how fast the half-term is going by in Class 2! In English, Year 1 and 2 have been inspired by 'The Enormous Turnip', using it as the basis for our creative story writing. The children have loved re-enacting, retelling and innovating the tale, showing some great imagination in their own ideas.

In Maths, we are becoming times table superstars as we build confidence with our multiplication skills. Alongside this, we have been exploring concepts such as length and height and time, learning to read clocks and understand how time is measured in our daily lives.

We took advantage of the beautiful weather earlier this half term to take our Music lessons outdoors, where the children enjoyed composing their own music pieces on glockenspiels. We have also been developing our mapping skills in Geography by learning how to map our classroom, school and grounds.

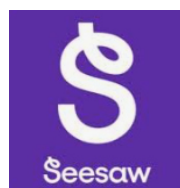
