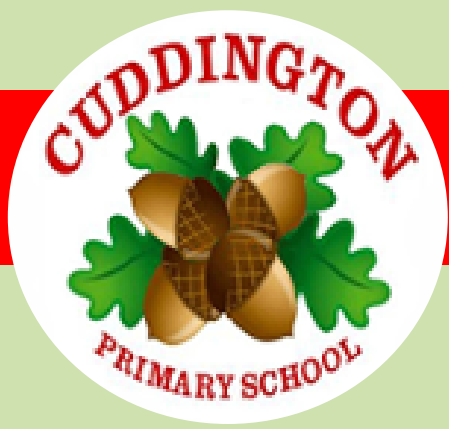

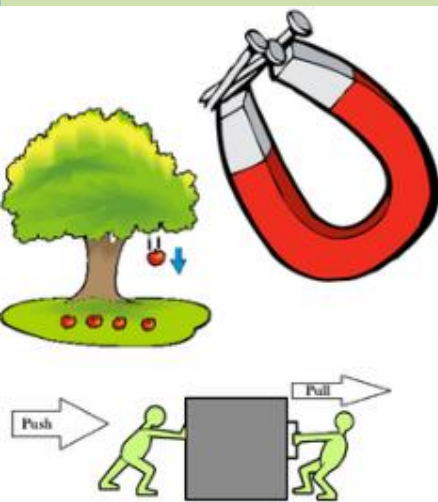

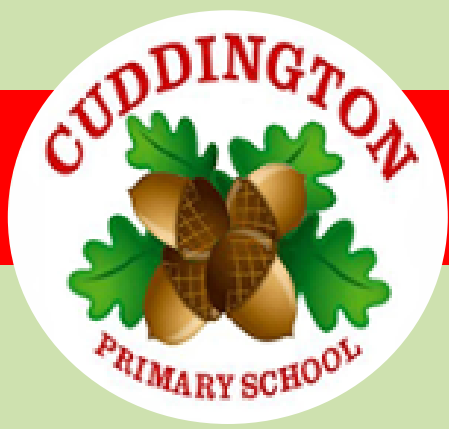

Uniform

P.E.

- P.E. uniform – Plain white t-shirt or Cuddington Primary School t-shirt, tracksuit joggers/pants/shorts, suitable trainers, hoodie / jumper / zip-up hoodie, hat and gloves

P.E.

- Children will be asked to remove them or cover earrings with tape (provided by parents)



Homework

- Spelling (Spelling Shed)
- Maths (TTRockstars / Maths Shed / My Maths)

Homework should be completed by the following **Wednesday**

Children will receive 2 pieces of online homework during the Autumn, Spring and Summer Term (via email)



Reading

- In Year 3, it is expected that your child reads for 15 minutes every day (levelled book)
- Sign their reading diary after they have read
- Essential to encourage a love for reading, to develop new vocabulary and strengthen writing skills
- Ask questions about events that have happened so far, characters' thoughts and motives and make accurate predictions
- Your child will be able to bring home library books or reading books from the class library



Spelling Shed, TTRockstars, Maths Shed, My Maths and Letter Join

- The children have received logins
- Can be accessed via website or app
- Supports English and Maths learning
- Access at home, using their logins





Please provide

- Water bottle with water for your child daily. Hydration is important to good health and learning!
- If children don't order a snack from school, provide a healthy snack for them to eat at break (low sugar and/or low fat)
If it is deemed an unhealthy option, they will be asked to save it for later by staff members

- Year 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6
- Reading and Maths
- End of Autumn Term (December)
