SUMMER 1

We have an exciting (and delicious!) half term ahead in Year 3, with lots of learning linked to our chocolate theme.

English

This half term, our writing will be inspired by some fantastic texts including Mr Bunny's Chocolate Factory, Chocolate Cake, and Charlie and the Chocolate Factory, alongside a variety of non-fiction texts all about... chocolate! The children will be creating a range of writing, including poetry, non-chronological reports and letters.

Maths

In Maths, we will continue building our confidence with fractions. The children will explore both unit and non-unit fractions, as well as learning how to add and subtract them. Later in the half term, we will move on to money, where pupils will learn how to convert, add and subtract pounds and pence.

Science

Our Science topic focuses on light. The children will identify different light sources and learn why light is essential for seeing. They will also investigate what happens when there is no light and explore how shadows are formed.

Geography

In Geography, we will be exploring the world's biomes and looking at where our food comes from. We will map food imports and learn about fair trade, with a special focus on cocoa beans and Fairtrade chocolate.

Religious Education

This half term, children will explore the idea of life as a journey. They will think about important milestones and experiences that mark different stages in people's lives.

Art & Design Technology

We will be taking inspiration from the illustrator Quentin Blake, creating our own artwork in his unique style using sketching and painting techniques. In Design Technology, the children will have the exciting opportunity to design, make and package their very own chocolates!

Music

Our music lessons will be full of energy and fun! We'll explore songs from Charlie and the Chocolate Factory, as well as dive into the vibrant world of samba music. The children will learn about traditional instruments, rhythms and the lively sounds of carnival.

PE

Alongside our regular PE lessons, the children will also be taking part in swimming lessons.
