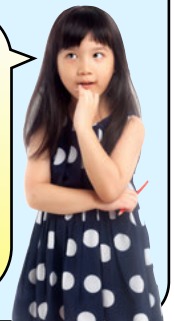

I had a lovely walk home yesterday through the fields, admiring all the pretty spring flowers, when suddenly I realised my basket was empty!

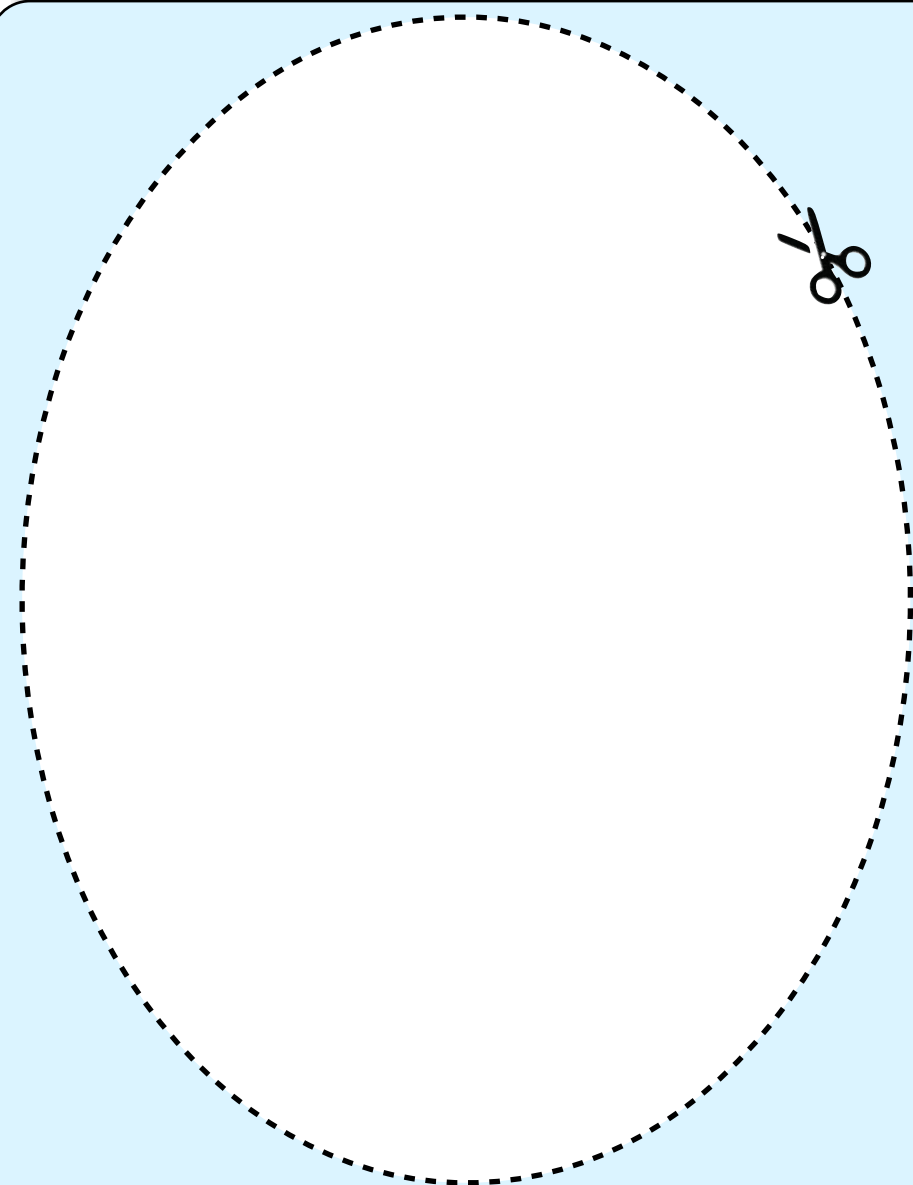
The eggs had all fallen out of my basket.

**You will need:** the egg template, scissors, pencil, 2 pieces of A5 card, multi-coloured tissue paper and glue.

1. Cut out the egg template and use it to draw an egg shape on one of your pieces of A5 card. Cut out the egg shape using the scissors very carefully.

2. Place the card with the cut out egg on top of your second piece of card and draw round the inside of your egg to create another egg shape. (Do not cut out)

3. Place strips of tissue paper across the second egg shape to create a pattern and stick down with glue. Once you have covered your egg, place the first piece over the top and glue around the edge.
